Description

This UK SME that has a strong creative and innovative business has developed a device no larger then a small smart phone.

This device sits inside a domestic pillow and uses differing methods to a traditional alarm system in order to wake people from sleep. It is also capable of reminding individuals of business/personal appointments, give travel updates and also has the ability to detect smoke, similar to smoke alarms.

The device will operate via Bluetooth. It has a speaker for sound but also uses vibration and has capabilities for smoke alarm detection. Having Bluetooth will enable the owner to program their calendar, plan and structure their working week, plan their social calendar much the same way as a mobile phone. It would also be useful in dwellings to help detect smoke much more quickly, so useful for domestic housing as well as care homes, hospitals and nurseries, individuals with health issues or impairments.

The company is seeking partnerships with manufacturers that will help in building, testing and distributing the devices. It may also be interested in a joint venture with a company that already has the capabilities and knowledge in house. This could be an Internet of Things (IoT) company that would be able to help develop the patent, advise on any adaptations needed in the development stage or during the testing stage. Or a bedding linen manufacturer who has an in house research and development team looking at new technologies.
