General Information

Short summary

Basque company (north of Spain) that designs and produces textile complements and garments with natural materials (vintage fabrics, linen, cotton and wool) looks for suppliers of such fabrics and other complements under a supplier agreement.

Full description

The company's owner was raised in a family background of textiles where she sewed all the clothes she could not afford by that time. It was pure chance that led the owner to come across an old fabrics' warehouse. These fabrics were aimed at covering mattresses, made of cotton, stamped in colourful combinations of damasks. She then decided to reuse that material that had captivated her and turn it into beautiful bags and other accessories.

Next step was to sign a manufacturing agreement with a cooperative for employability in a way that work could be provided for people in need of a second change in the labour market. This company is a project that pursues the objectives of the circular economy; it has a philosophy of zero waste, promotes social and labour integration and it underlines the importance of the perfect combination of design + sustainability.

Products are made out of either linen or cotton and are mainly bags: – hanging, travelling, beach, handbags, purses, rug packs, beach towels, portfolios (see pictures). At present, they are launching new collections of garments. Some of the fabrics the company works with come from that old warehouse. They were manufactured many years ago and aimed at upholstering furniture or simply at covering up mattresses. Their colour and thread quality remains still

intact. Nevertheless, the pieces that are cut are selected ones and must be in a perfect state. It must be borne in mind that these fabrics are no longer produced so the company has to make do with the pieces they actually have. In that sense, the company is trying to reproduce those old vintage patterns to make up for the lack of these types of fabrics.

The company wishes to be supplied with materials: linen, cotton, wool and vintage fabrics as far as possible and in significant quantities. Likewise, they look for a supplier of complements: bottoms, ribbons, zips, labels and similar under a supplier agreement.
